Historian continues to add genealogy information to the Family Tree Maker software program. Currently there are 4469 individual names, 1623 marriages, 19 generations and 1179 individual surnames in the program. Earliest birth year

is 1570 (Jagli Detwiler, 5th great grandfather of Henry R. Detwiler). Most recent birth is 20 February 2017 (William Phillip Drauschak, 4th great grandson of Abraham Detwiler). An updated genealogy CD dated Sept. 9th, 2016 and the original

genealogy hand kept documents are available at the Historical Society in Phoenixville for everyone to access. This will be updated in August after the 121st Reunion..
