Children enjoyed a Slip and Slide, made crafts to take home under the direction of our Vice President, Jean Schwartz and Pam Schwartz along with games enjoyed on the premises of Camp Innabah.

We have done: Dick Lusch, Historian continues to add genealogy information to the Family Tree Maker software program. Currently there are 4493 individual names, 1631 marriages, 19 generations and 1184 individual surnames in the program. Earliest birth year is 1570 (Jagli Detwiler, 5th great grandfather of Henry R. Detwiler). Most recent birth is 1 October 2017 (Maderlick Mark Zurat, 5th great grandson of Abraham Detwiler). An updated genealogy CD dated Sept. 6th, 2017 and the original genealogy hand kept documents are available at the Historical Society in Phoenixville for everyone to access. This will be updated in September after the 122nd Reunion...

We would like to: Keep all family genealogy information current by members contacting the Historian, with updates about family births, marriages, deaths and other information throughout the vear as it becomes available.

Family Tree Maker (our genealogy software program) is now owned by and supported by Software Mackiev Company. They were the provider of Family Tree Maker to Ancestry and now own it. They have made enhancements and have incorporated Ancestry's Tree Sync into their program.
